

2023 WINTER SHOW INFORMATION SHEET

DRESS REHEARSAL INFO (January 16-19):

- o Dancers should wear dance costumes to class AT THE STUDIO January 16-20 (unless otherwise noted).
- o Recreational and Pre-Competition classes' dress rehearsals will be on normal class day/time.
Competition Teams should wear black dancewear and BRING Winter Recital COSTUME/ACCESSORIES to change into for their class(es)/teacher(s) that are performing in the winter recitals.
- o See charts on PAGES 3-5 for tentative show orders and costume information (show specific). Teachers will clarify details at the dress rehearsal classes once they see the costumes in action.
- o Hair and make-up **does not need to be done for DRESS REHEARSALS unless directed otherwise by your teacher.** However, if you have a hairpiece, it is strongly recommended that you put it in for our dress rehearsal class to practice and to be sure it stays in during the dance. **Competition and Pre-Competition Teams with special hairstyles should practice the hairstyle for the dress rehearsal.**
- o Recreational dancers need to have make-up in the following colors for the actual recitals: taupe/beige shimmer eye shadow, soft pink blush, true RED lipstick, and black eyeliner/mascara.
- o Competition dancers should have purchased the appropriate make-up and lipstick colors. Lipstick color is noted on the chart for competition teams and should be verified at dress rehearsals with your teacher.
- o Parents should plan to attend a short meeting for the last 10 minutes of class on the "dress rehearsal" days to discuss the costumes/hair/etc. for recital day. PLEASE WAIT by the studio door to be invited in for the meeting.
- o **THE WINTER SHOW DRESS REHEARSALS WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE STUDIO during regular class times (NOT AT THE SCHOOL)!!!**

To ensure your child's safety and a finished look, please remember to make the necessary alterations to your child's costume PRIOR TO OUR DRESS REHEARSAL CLASSES. Also, remember to hang your costume up and take good care of it. Some will need to be steamed, ironed with a COOL iron, or hung in a steamy bathroom to release the wrinkles they acquired while they were packaged and shipped. Find the appropriate undergarments to use with your child's costume. Dancers should wear skin colored underwear or wear tights without underwear. Older dancers should wear a skin-colored bra with clear straps.

RECITAL DAY INFORMATION

- Our LMSD Winter Recitals will take place on Sunday, January 22nd at 1 PM, 3 PM, and 5 PM.
- RECITALS TAKE PLACE AT THE MONTICELLO HIGH SCHOOL (5225 School Blvd) in the Performing Arts Center (auditorium).
- Recreational and Prec-competition dancers WILL BE SITTING IN THE AUDITORIUM with their family as spectators. We want to give the dancers the opportunity to watch and support the other dancers in the show! 😊 **YOU DO NOT NEED TO PAY LMSD for the SEAT FOR YOUR DANCER.** We will share a code to give you one free ticket so you can include a seat with your order for your dancer free of charge (processing fees will still apply to this ticket which go directly to the ticketing company). For families who have more than one dancer participating, your code should allow for a free ticket for each of your performing dancers. If your child is in more than one recital, you should get a separate code for each recital. **If your family has a special circumstance, please email Lucy before ticket sales open to be sure you have the correct coupon code. If you do not receive your coupon code by tomorrow (December 28), please e-mail Lucy.**
- **REMEMBER - there are NO coupon codes for Competition Dancers.** Since they are in multiple shows and they will sit with their team members, and not with their families, they do not need a ticket.

- **Wheelchair seating and folding chairs are offered in addition to regular auditorium seating** (which will require audience members to navigate stairs).
- We have **hired a videographer who will be recording the winter recitals**. As published in our start of the year paperwork, handbook and on our website, each family will receive links to the recitals as part of their **winter recital fee of \$25** per family. This **fee will be added to your account and due with January tuition**. Tickets to attend the shows in person are purchased separately from the winter recital fee.
- **Dancers should sit with family in the auditorium until 4 songs before they are scheduled to dance**. At this time they should exit the back doors of the auditorium between songs and go to the staging area in main street (near the bench by the staircase). Staff will be at the staging area to help dancers warm-up, stretch and get lined up to perform.
- **We will start sending dancers out to main street to practice and prepare for the show 10 minutes before show time**. Lucy will help by announcing when it is time for each group to head to main street.
- **Once dancers have performed on stage, they will use the stairs inside the auditorium to go back to sit with their parents to watch the remainder of the show**.
- **Parents with young children are welcome to walk them to the staging area, as well as to come help get your child after they perform** (*standing and waving/calling them may work as well*).
- **Doors will open 20 minutes before show time** (12:40 for the 1:00 PM show, 2:40 for the 3:00 PM show, and 4:40 PM for the 5:00 PM Show).
- **Tickets are assigned seating and show specific**. Use care to purchase tickets to the correct recital time.
- Please **refrain from using flash photography** at the recital for the safety of the dancers on stage.
- **Park on the WEST side of the Monticello HIGH School (closer to Little Mountain) and enter the school through the WEST set of doors**.
- Please do your best to **enter or exit** the auditorium **BETWEEN SONGS** during the recital. If you enter during a dance, wait until it is done to go to your seats.
- **ALL Recreational GROUPS SHOULD WEAR THE FOLLOWING MAKE-UP COLORS:** TAUPE/BEIGE SHIMMERY EYE SHADOW, SOFT PINK BLUSH, TRUE RED LIPSTICK AND BLACK EYELINER/MASCARA.
- **UNLESS SPECIFIED OTHERWISE, HAIR SHOULD BE CURLED, AND PULLED INTO A HIGH PONYTAIL**. If your child wears a hat, the ponytail will need to be low (at the nape of the neck) and then the hair should be parted on the dancer's left side. Otherwise, it should be up high on the back of the head.
- **ANY hair accessories SHOULD BE SECURELY ATTACHED TO THE BACK/UPPER RIGHT SIDE OF THE DANCER'S HEAD** (near the side of the ponytail) unless told otherwise at your dress rehearsal meeting or in the costume description.
- **Please review the tentative show(s) order for your child on PAGE 4-8 for each recital and contact Lucy if you see any issues**.
- **You can also find a description of costume/hair together with the show orders below**. Teachers will clarify items at the parent meeting at dress rehearsals at the studio Jan 16-19.

TICKET ORDERING INFORMATION:

Tickets will be for sale through an outside ticketing agency. **Dance Recital Ticketing** will be handling our winter show ticket sales this year.

- To order, you will visit their site.
- Be sure to select the **CORRECT RECITAL TIME(s)**.
- Take into consideration where your child will be standing on the stage (see diagram of auditorium at the end of this document on page 7).
- Check out and make payment directly to Dance Recital Ticketing.
- **Print your tickets OR bookmark your e-tickets to show them on your mobile device the day of the show**.

- **DO NOT PAY FOR A TICKET FOR YOUR DANCER**. All recreation and pre-comp dance families should use the code to get a free ticket for your performing dancer (Dance Ticketing Processing will still apply). All competition dancers do NOT need a ticket.
- **All recreational and pre-comp dance families will receive a code via e-mail by the end of the day December 27th to use when they order tickets. This code will give you one free ticket for your dancer so you can select a seat for them with your family group. If you have two recreational dancers performing in the same recital, you should get a code for two free tickets.** All LMSD ticket fees will be waived, however, the processing fees charged by Dance Recital Ticketing will still apply on the dancer tickets. Dancers will sit in the auditorium and watch the recital with their family. They will go out to Main Street to warm-up/stretch/run their dance 4 songs before they perform. ***We will announce when each group should go to main street on the sound system*** in the auditorium to keep things running smoothly.
- **Competition dancers are in all three recitals. They will sit as a group (WITH A PARENT VOLUNTEER) in the back of the auditorium** when they are not dancing. Parents of (Rubies, Emeralds, Sapphires) - **Please sign up to volunteer/supervise your child's group for a recital opposite of the one you plan to watch at this link:**

No ticket needed for competition parents who are help supervise a group.
 - **Diamond and Onyx dancers** will be assisting with backstage jobs, and will sit as a group to watch in the back of the auditorium when able.
 - **12th grade/Seniors** will receive an e-mail directly from Dance Recital Ticketing with a special link to gain access to early ticket sales by the end of the day (December 27). This link should open sales to these students from **8 AM Tuesday, January 3 through the end of the day Wednesday, January 4.**
 - **Tickets for ALL OTHERS will open 8 AM on Thursday, January 5.** For best seating options, we recommend you order tickets as soon as possible. ***Recreational and Pre-comp families, remember to locate and use your coupon*** (the coupon will come in a separate email)! Refunds are not available once purchases are made, so please plan ahead and have your coupon code ready at the time you place your purchase.
 - **You may share the ordering link with family and friends** who want to purchase their own tickets.
 - ***NO paper tickets will be sold on the day of the shows at the door, but the on-line ticket ordering link will still be open to purchase until 30 minutes into each recital.***

The Winter Show is a busy day! Thank you for your support and encouragement. Please have your child practice his/her dance over the next few weeks, and also run through it at home a few times before coming to the recital on January 22nd!

Please plan to arrive to the school 20 minutes before show time (or earlier if indicated below). Doors will open 20 minutes before show time. You may go into the auditorium and find your seats with your child. **BE SURE YOU GET YOUR CHILD INTO COSTUME/SHOES WHEN YOU ARRIVE SO THEY ARE READY TO REPORT BACKSTAGE WHEN REQUESTED.** Lucy will announce/remind students when it is their time to go out to the auditorium to prepare to perform. Remember we will start calling groups to the staging area to warm-up/prepare 10 minutes before show time.

Competition Teams should arrive at the following times to run their dances. Then they will sit as a group with a parent volunteer in the back of the auditorium to watch until it is their time to perform.
